Welcome to 'Dee Code Breakers', a treasure hunt with a difference! The 26 letters of the alphabet are represented by a number in the Code Table below. You must find number

clues hidden around Donaghadee, work out which letter they represent, and fill in the missing letters to crack each of the words in our Easter Code. To help you along the way, we have filled in some numbers for you. Once you crack the Easter Code, post your entry in the Bethel Hall mailbox, or send us a copy via social media.

Enjoy the hunt anytime from 08 April 2022, however, if you participate on Saturday 09 April 2022 as part of the Bethel Big Easter Weekend, there will be free refreshments available at the finish line from 2pm-4pm. Answers will be revealed on the Bethel Hall YouTube Channel after 25 April 2022, with a Role of Honour for all participants.

The starting point is the town car park near the old Sir Samuel Kelly lifeboat (head towards the harbour, turn right, pass the Community Centre car park, and follow the road into the town car park). You can select from one of two routes this year:

The Black Run- 2.5 miles with 18 clues The Red Run- 1.5 miles with 12 clues

The Red Run is based around the town centre, while The Black Run first solves 6 additional clues before joining The Red Run route. Both runs finish 0.5 miles from the town car park. Now let's get you to the starting line and start CODE BREAKING!

Exit the car park where the cars all drive in, And there at the junction is where you begin. For Red Run turn left, for Black Run turn right, And then your first clues will come into sight.
